Re: Policy on Out-of-Province Examination Applicants and Registration Applicants

POLICY: Pan-Canadian Examination Applicants (CTCMA) & Registration Applicants (CTCMA)

1. Examination candidates must meet CTCMA examination requirements.
2. Applicants who meet CTCMA requirements will be eligible to sit the Pan-Canadian examination as a CTCMA candidate.
3. Applicants who pass both components of the Pan-Canadian Examination in Canada will be eligible to apply for registration with CTCMA
4. Both of the components of the Pan-Canadian Examination must be taken within 3 years from the examination dates effective October 2017.
5. Applicants will be approved for registration if they meet all other registration requirements as stated in the CTCMA bylaws.
6. Once an applicant's registration is approved, the applicant becomes a registrant and will be entitled to all privileges of a registrant.
7. One of the privileges a registrant is entitled to is the Agreement of Internal Trade – Labour Mobility: A registrant of CTCMA may apply to register in another province on the basis of Labour Mobility provided that the registrant meets all other registration requirements of the other province.
